

GCE ADVANCED LEVEL SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 206 students in Year 13 who took A Level exams in 2021/2022.

Grades A to E are passes at A Level, grade U is unclassified.

The pass rate at A Level was 99.8%.

The average number of 'A' Levels gained per candidate was 3.2.

60% of entries passed at grades A and A*; 86%* of entries were passed at grades A*, A and B; 96% were grades A* to C.

The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 138 (based on grade A*=56, A=48 pts., B=40, etc.)

82% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A*/A pass, 62% each gained two or more grade A*/A passes including 67 students who each gained three or more A*/A grades.



GCSE SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 126 pupils in Year 11 in 2021/22. Pupils sat reformed GCSE specifications which awarded 9 to 1 grades.
