The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 133 (based on grade A*=56, A=48 pts., B=40, etc.)

74% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A*/A pass, 47% each gained two or more grade A*/A passes, including 65 students who each gained three or more A*/A grades.
